PRIVACY STATEMENT & CONSENTS

A member's personal information is held as a record in the Chess Valley U3A secure central membership system. A member is able to access their personal record to view and amend their personal information which includes the three consents to the use of their information by Chess Valley U3A.

By removing consent 2 you will no longer receive your newsletter by post, although you may collect your copy at a General Meeting.

3 Consent to my data being shared with the company who oversees the distribution of the Third Age Trust Magazines. New members completing paper applications - If you do **NOT** wish to give consent circle **NO** against option (b) in section 4 of the paper form. New members applying online/Existing members – **update** your Simple Membership profile, or contact membership@cvu3a.uk.

By removing consent 3 you will no longer receive the Third Age Matters magazine, even if paid for.
